As a community gardener, I understand the following:

- Dues for the 2014 gardening season are \$35 for each plot, roughly 10 feet by 10 feet. This fee includes the cost of water, compost and seeds, if available.
- Only organic pesticides, herbicides and fertilizers are used.
- I will participate in group tasks, such as weeding common areas, caring for community plantings and areas, and caring for gardening tools.
- I will make every effort to attend periodic program meetings.
- I will contribute to community workdays.
- I may be able to obtain seeds at low or no cost through Anythink Libraries.
