- 3. Public Comment: None.
- 4. <u>Consent Agenda Item</u>: Motion to approve the Minutes of the October 16, 2013 Regular Board Meeting and the Proposed 2014 Trustee Meeting Schedule was made by Trustee Coffey and seconded by Trustee Glenn. Motion Carried.
- **5.** <u>Director's Report Pam Sandlian Smith</u>: Work on finalizing the 2014 Operating Plan continues, Pam will report to the Board in January. The Leadership team will visit STEM on Tuesday and will participate in solving a real life problem. The L.A. public library will visit tomorrow and Friday. We have submitted an unrestricted grant application to the Morgridge Family Foundation for \$5000.
- 6. Finance Manager's Report Rebecca Martin: Rebecca reviewed the 2013 Budget Amendment. She stated the 2014 Budget was presented at the October meeting and that there were no changes. The public hearing opened at 5:16 pm, with no public comments, the hearing closed at 5:18pm. - 7. <u>Public Service Director's Report- Ronnie Storey</u>: Ronnie's report included an update on the hospitality team; they will work with one other person at their branch and come up with ideas to continue connecting at the branch level.
- 8. <u>HR Director's Report Susan Dobbs</u>: Susan invited the Board to the staff appreciation breakfast, December 11. She handed out a draft of the employee handbook update/cleanup.
- 9. <u>Director of Special Project's Report Lynda Freas</u>: Lynda was at the Huron Street where there were 45+ teens participating in a Minecraft program where they competed against other branches. A grant has been submitted to American Honda for \$74,000 to help support the summer reading program, a grant was also submitted to help build raised planters in the Brighton Nature Explore classroom.
- 10. <u>IT Director's Report Matt Hamilton</u>: Matt reports the server replacement project is complete, TechFest planning is moving along. We will be participating in the "Hour of Code" initiative the week of December 9, which promotes computer science education. IT projects for next year include; circulation software for internal items and staff scheduling software.
- 11. <u>Collection Development Director's Report Logan Macdonald</u>: We will be working with Civic Technologies next year, and are busy working on behind the scene projects to prepare for this. We will soon be offering a product called Hoopla to our customers; this will give them immediate access to movies, TV shows, music and audiobooks.
- 12. <u>Communications Director's Report Stacie Ledden</u>: Our Foundation will be participating in Colorado Gives Day this year, December 10. Stacie reports that on Saturday our director Pam was a speaker at TEDx MileHigh and represented Anythink very well.
