‘Discover Health’ exhibition announced

Community members invited to explore exhibition at Anythink Brighton

THORNTON, Colo.—Nov. 2, 2016—Beginning Friday, Nov. 4, Anythink hosts *Discover Health*, an exhibition produced by the Space Science Institute’s [National Center for Interactive Learning](#) (NCIL) and on display at [Anythink Brighton](#). *Discover Health* is an opportunity for community members of all ages to explore healthy living and the body through interactive experiences. The exhibition, which focuses on public health issues and ways to improve overall personal health, runs through Wednesday, Jan. 4, 2017. Anythink Brighton will celebrate this exhibition with an opening reception on Saturday, Nov. 12, from 10 am-1 pm, which is free and open to the public.
